Go to www.highered.nysed.gov/tcert/teach

Log on to TEACH with your username and password

Click on "TEACH Online Services"

Click on "Apply for Certificate"

Make selections from drop boxes to select certificate title:

Submit payment for application (\$50 online using a credit card)

PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATION

Once you meet the requirements for Professional Certification, you will be able to apply for Professional Certification by following the same steps and using the same program code.

Requirements for Professional Certification:

- Praxis II Exam Speech & Language Disabilities
- 3 years of paid, full time Classroom Teaching experience
- Mentored experience
